We are pleased to share information about a new underground electric transmission project – **Propel NY Energy** – that will directly benefit you and your community.

What is Propel NY?

The New York Power Authority (NYPA) and New York Transco – two experienced New York companies – are developing Propel NY, new underground and submarine transmission lines and new substations in parts of Long Island, New York City and Westchester County. Propel NY will bolster the reliability and resiliency of the energy delivery backbone in your community and create paths for clean energy to reach customers. Why is Propel NY needed?

Propel NY will build critical energy connections to improve your community's long-term safety, security, and quality of life by providing a state-of-the-art power grid that will:

- help meet current and future demand as we use more electricity every day to power devices, light, cool and heat homes, and run businesses;
- reliably and resiliently move power during blue sky days and the worst of storms;
- support healthier communities by moving cleaner power with fewer carbon emissions;
- encourage economic development and support job and business growth locally and throughout the state.

When will Propel NY occur?

We are in the early phases of Propel NY. We are informing local stakeholders and residents about the project and will begin the permitting process later this year. You may see survey crews and our team in local areas supporting the Project. The key permitting process, led by the New York State Public Service Commission, includes environmental, engineering and construction review, as well as regular community outreach to incorporate feedback from area stakeholders like you. After receiving approvals, construction is anticipated to start in 2026. Construction will occur in phases until completion in mid-2030.
